



The interior renovation of this condominium converted a cramped and divided two bedroom two-bath unit into a spacious and open one bedroom two-bath unit. Inspired by the client's collection of art, the design focused on creating a backdrop for the art collection. The renovation removed walls and closets to take advantage of the spectacular city and capitol views. The main space is divided visually with a curved ceiling and soffit, and fabric curtain that defines a casual den space for the "hi-fi" sound system. The kitchen was relocated and redesigned with new millwork and appliances. The master closet was replaced with an efficient and space saving built-in wardrobe. The new bathroom creates a spa like sense of tranquility while providing a commanding view of the capitol building from the large soaking tub. Classic modern furniture and fixtures create a timeless and sophisticated quality.
