

## WATER HOUSE



This 2,600 square foot home on a secluded site in west Austin utilizes formal geometries to define space and function. Inspired by contemporary Mexican architecture, the experience of the house is dominated by brightly colored stucco walls. A round purple chimney, red metal windows and a curved roof contrast against the neutral olive green stucco façade. Bold colors and geometries are also utilized on the interior of the home in dramatic accent walls and custom metalwork. Rated as a five-star project in the Austin Green Building Program, the home incorporates sustainable materials and a rainwater collection system.
